## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## **Equal Opportunities Employment Act**

- FOR the purpose of providing that, if a capital project receives more than a certain amount in federal or State funds, the recipients of the funds and their contractors and subcontractors shall award contracts to business concerns that provide opportunities for certain low-income individuals; requiring the Department of General Services to adopt certain regulations; stating the intent of the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to requirements for recipients of certain State funds for certain capital projects.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article State Finance and Procurement
- 18 **3–610.**
- 19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 20 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 21 **(2)** "BUSINESS CONCERN THAT PROVIDES ECONOMIC 22 OPPORTUNITIES" MEANS A BUSINESS THAT:

- 1 (I) EMPLOYS A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF LOW-INCOME 2 INDIVIDUALS OR VERY LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS; OR
- 3 (II) MEETS OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE 4 DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES.
- 5 (3) "LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO 6 RECEIVES TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE UNDER THE FAMILY INVESTMENT 7 PROGRAM UNDER TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE HUMAN SERVICES ARTICLE 8 WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS.
- 9 (4) "VERY LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL 10 WHO HAS RECEIVED UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS DURING THE 11 PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS.
- 12 IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT, TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, RECIPIENTS OF FEDERAL OR STATE FUNDS FOR 13 14 CAPITAL PROJECTS AND THEIR CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS SHALL 15 WITH BUSINESS CONCERNS **THAT PROVIDE** OPPORTUNITIES FOR LOW- AND VERY LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS WHEN 16 17 CONSTRUCTING CAPITAL PROJECTS.
- 18 (C) If a capital project receives \$5,000,000 or more in federal 19 or State funds, the recipients of the funds and their contractors 20 and subcontractors shall award contracts for work to be 21 performed in connection with the capital project to business 22 concerns that provide economic opportunities for low- and very 23 low-income individuals in at least 5% of the skilled and unskilled 24 positions associated with the project.
- 25 (D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL ADOPT 26 REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE 27 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 28 (2) THE REGULATIONS SHALL ESTABLISH CRITERIA THAT A
  29 BUSINESS CONCERN THAT PROVIDES ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR
  30 LOW- AND VERY LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS MUST MEET.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 July 1, 2011.
