## State Payments of Public School Construction Costs - Remittance of Reimbursement to County

FOR the purpose of requiring the State, when the State provides reimbursement of forward-funded public school construction or public school capital improvement projects, to remit the funds to the county government for certain payments; prohibiting the State from remitting reimbursement funds to the county board of education; and generally relating to State payments of public school construction and capital improvement costs.

Article - Education
Section 5-301(h-1)
Annotated Code of Maryland (2008 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education
5-301.
(H-1) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WHEN THE STATE REIMBURSES THE COSTS OF A FORWARD-FUNDED PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, THE STATE SHALL REMIT THE FUNDS TO THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

(2) THE REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS RECEIVED BY A COUNTY GOVERNMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR REQUIRED PAYMENTS FOR DEBT INCURRED BY THE COUNTY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.
(3) THE STATE MAY NOT REMIT REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS TO THE COUNTY BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2011.
