# 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Environment – Dishwashing Detergent Containing Phosphorus – Penalties

FOR the purpose of altering the establishing a certain penalty for knowingly selling,
manufacturing, or distributing for use or sale within the State certain
household dishwashing detergents after a certain date; establishing that each
pound of a cleaning agent sold, distributed, or manufactured in violation of a
certain provision of law is a separate violation; repealing obsolete language; and
generally relating to dishwashing detergents containing phosphorus.

#### **SENATE BILL 751**

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Environment

5 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person may not use, 6 sell, manufacture, or distribute for use or sale within the State any cleaning agent 7 that contains more than 0.0 percent phosphorus by weight expressed as elemental 8 phosphorus except for an amount not exceeding 0.5 percent phosphorus that is 9 incidental to manufacturing.

10 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person may use, sell, 11 manufacture, or distribute for use or sale a cleaning agent that contains greater than 12 0.0 percent phosphorus by weight, but does not exceed 8.7 percent phosphorus by 13 weight that is:

14 (1) A detergent used in a dishwashing machine, whether commercial 15 or household; or

16 (2) A substance the Secretary, by rule and regulation, excludes from 17 the 0.0 percent phosphorus limitation of subsection (a) of this section based on a 18 finding that compliance with this section would:

(i) Create a significant hardship on the user; or

20 (ii) Be unreasonable because of the lack of an adequate 21 substitute cleaning agent.

22 (c) [After July 1, 2010, a] **A** person may not use, sell, manufacture, or 23 distribute for use or sale within the State any detergent for use in a household 24 dishwashing machine that contains more than 0.5 percent phosphorus by weight.

26 (a) (1) Any person who uses a cleaning agent in violation of this subtitle is 27 guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100.

28 (2) (I) [Any] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF 29 THIS PARAGRAPH, ANY person who sells, distributes, or manufactures a cleaning 30 agent in violation of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is 31 subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
