A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Task Force to Study High School Dropout Rates of Persons in the Criminal Justice System

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study High School Dropout Rates $\mathbf{5}$ of Persons in the Criminal Justice System; providing for the membership and 6 staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Governor to designate the chair of the 7Task Force; providing that a member of the Task Force may not receive 8 compensation as a member of the Task Force but is entitled to a certain 9 reimbursement; requiring the Task Force to study certain issues and to make certain reports to the Governor and General Assembly; providing for the 10 11 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study High School Dropout Rates of Persons in the Criminal Justice System. 12
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- (a) There is a Task Force to Study High School Dropout Rates of Persons inthe Criminal Justice System.
- 17 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 19 President of the Senate;
- 20 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 21 of the House;
- (3) the State Superintendent of Education, or the Superintendent'sdesignee;

It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.	

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
