Education – Open Space on Public School Property – Planting and Maintaining Gardens

4 FOR the purpose of requiring county boards of education to encourage the use of open 5 space on public school property for a certain purpose; requiring certain county 6 boards to permit the use of certain public school property for certain purposes 7 during certain times by certain groups subject to certain requirements; 8 requiring certain groups to submit certain plans to the county superintendent of 9 schools; requiring certain groups to limit the application of pesticides under 10 certain circumstances; authorizing certain county boards to incorporate the use of school gardens into certain curriculum guides and courses of study; 11 12 authorizing county boards to use certain produce in school cafeterias in 13 accordance with certain laws and regulations; and generally relating to the use 14 of open space on public school property for the planting and maintaining of school gardens. 15

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 4 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL AUTHORIZE THE USE OF OPEN SPACE ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANTING AND MAINTAINING GARDENS THROUGHOUT THE CALENDAR YEAR BY SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY GROUPS.
- 8 (C) EACH SCHOOL OR COMMUNITY GROUP THAT PLANTS OR MAINTAINS 9 A GARDEN ON SCHOOL PROPERTY SHALL:
- 10 (1) SUBMIT A PLAN TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FOR
 11 MAINTENANCE OF THE GARDEN WHEN THE SCHOOL IS NOT OPEN DURING THE
 12 REGULAR SCHOOL CALENDAR YEAR; AND
- 13 (2) LIMIT THE APPLICATION OF PESTICIDES TO THE GARDEN 14 THROUGH THE USE OF ORGANIC VEGETABLE GARDENING TECHNIQUES OR 15 INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT.

16 (D) A COUNTY BOARD MAY:

- 17 (1) INCORPORATE THE USE OF SCHOOL GARDENS INTO THE CURRICULUM GUIDES AND COURSES OF STUDY RELATING TO NUTRITION, 19 HEALTH, AND HORTICULTURE INSTRUCTION FOR THE SCHOOLS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION; AND
- 21 (2) USE THE PRODUCE GROWN IN SCHOOL GARDENS IN SCHOOL 22 CAFETERIAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS AND 23 REGULATIONS GOVERNING FOOD SAFETY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
