2 **St. Mary's County Board of Elections – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the members of the St. Mary's County Board
4 of Elections; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or
5 compensation of the incumbent members of the St. Mary's County Board of
6 Elections; and generally relating to the salary of the members of the St. Mary's
7 County Board of Elections.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Election Law**

16 2–204.

17 (a) Each regular member of a local board shall receive the salary and
18 reimbursement of expenses provided in the county budget, but in no event may the
19 annual compensation be less than the following amounts:

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
3 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
4 the salary or compensation of the members of the St. Mary’s County Board of Elections
5 during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the
6 provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the St. Mary’s County
7 Board of Elections shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of
8 office.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 ~~July~~ June 1, 2011.
