16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Natural Resources

19 10-301.1.

(a) (1) (i) On or after July 1, 1977, a person under 18 years of age may
not procure a hunting license or hunt in the State[,] unless the person has first been
issued a certificate of competency in firearms and hunter safety.

(ii) On or after July 1, 1977, a person, regardless of age, may not
 procure a hunting license without producing a certificate of competency or a hunting
