14	(a) (1) There is a county board of elections in each county of the State.		
15 16 17 18	(2) Each local board and its staff is subject to the direction and authority of the State Board and is accountable to the State Board for its actions in all matters regarding the implementation of the requirements of this article and any applicable federal law.		
19 20	(b) (1) Except as provided in subsections (j), (k), and (l) of this section, each local board consists of three regular members and two substitute members.		
21 22 23	(2) Two regular members and one substitute member shall be of the majority party, and one regular member and one substitute member shall be of the principal minority party.		
24 25 26 27 28	(3) Except as provided in subsection (l) of this section, in the event of the absence of a regular member or a vacancy in the office of a regular member, the substitute member of the same political party shall exercise the powers and duties of a regular member until the regular member returns or the vacancy is filled as prescribed in subsection (h) of this section.		
29 30 31	(l) (1) In CAROLINE COUNTY, SOMERSET COUNTY, Wicomico County, AND Worcester County, [and Somerset County,] the local board consists of five regular members.		
32 33	(2) Three regular members shall be of the majority party, and two regular members shall be of the principal minority party.		

If a vacancy occurs on the local board, the Governor shall

appoint an eligible person from the same political party as the predecessor member to

fill the vacancy in accordance with subsection (g) of this section for the remainder of the unexpired term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
(ii) An appointment made while the Senate of Maryland is not in session shall be considered temporary until the appointee is confirmed by the Senate.
2-204.
(a) Each regular member of a local board shall receive the salary and reimbursement of expenses provided in the county budget, but in no event may the annual compensation be less than the following amounts:
(6) in Caroline County, [\$2,750] \$3,250 for the president, [\$2,500] \$3,000 for other regular members, and reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of election duties in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations;
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Caroline County Board of Elections during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Caroline County Board of Elections shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. SECTION 2. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1 June 6, 2011.
