A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Continuing Care Facility for Aged Beer, Wine and Liquor License

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class CCFA (continuing care facility for the aged) $\mathbf{5}$ beer, wine and liquor license in Harford County; specifying that the Liquor 6 Control Board may issue a Class CCFA license to certain organizations that 7provide certain care, are licensed as a certain institution, are certified by a 8 certain department, are exempt from certain taxes, and are located in Harford 9 County: authorizing a Class CCFA license holder to sell alcoholic beverages for 10 consumption on the licensed premises under certain circumstances; setting the annual license fee; providing that certain prohibitions do not apply to this Act; 11 12and generally relating to beer, wine and liquor licenses in Harford County.

- 22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY.

23 (B) THERE IS A CLASS CCFA (CONTINUING CARE FACILITY FOR THE 24 AGED) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE IN HARFORD COUNTY.
