A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 – Prince George’s County –**
3 **Ivy Youth and Family Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to
5 extend the date by which a certain grantee must provide proof of a certain
6 matching fund; extending the deadline by which a certain grant must be
7 encumbered by the Board of Public Works or expended for certain purposes; and
8 generally relating to amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of
9 2004.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by
12 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004 and Chapter 707
13 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2009
14 Section 13(3)(i) Item (BD) and (ii) Item (Q)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of**
18 **2004 and Chapter 707 of the Acts of 2009**

19 SECTION 13. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

20 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the
21 Senate:

22 (BD) Ivy Youth and Family Center. Provide a grant equal to the

 2 provided, to the Board of Directors of Ivy Community

 4 planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of the
 5 Ivy Youth and Family Center, located in Prince George’s
 6 County. Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the
 7 matching fund may consist of real property, in kind
 8 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of
 9 this Act and the grantee must present evidence that a
 10 matching fund will be provided by June 1, [2011] **2013**.

 22 planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of the
 23 Ivy Youth and Family Center, located in Prince George’s
 24 County. Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the
 25 matching fund may consist of real property, in kind
 26 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of
 27 this Act and the grantee must present evidence that a
 28 matching fund will be provided by June 1, [2011] **2013**.
