A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Executive Order – Definition**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “executive order” to remove from the
4 definition an order or an amendment or a rescission of an order that adopts
5 certain guidelines, rules of conduct, or rules of procedure for certain persons;
6 and generally relating to the definition of “executive order”.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 3–401.

16 In this subtitle, “executive order” means an order or an amendment or
17 rescission of an order that, over the signature of the Governor:

18 (1) proclaims or ends a state of emergency or exercises the authority of
19 the Governor during an emergency, under Title 14, Subtitle 3 of the Public Safety
20 Article or any other provision of law;

21 (2) adopts guidelines, rules of conduct, or rules of procedure for:

- 1 (i) State employees; **OR**
- 2 (ii) units of the State government; [or
- 3 (iii) persons who are under the jurisdiction of those employees or
- 4 units or who deal with them;]
- 5 (3) establishes a unit, including an advisory unit, study unit, or task
- 6 force; or
- 7 (4) changes the organization of the Executive Branch of the State
- 8 government.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

10 October 1, 2011.
