Chapter 135

(House Bill 630)

AN ACT concerning

Building Standards - High-Performance Homes

FOR the purpose of providing that requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development, through certain measures, shall to encourage the construction of new residential structures that are high-performance homes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to green building standards for homes.

BY adding to

Article – Public Safety Section 12–502(d) <u>12–509</u> Annotated Code of Maryland (2003 Volume and 2010 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Public Safety

12-502. <u>12-509.</u>

(D) (A) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION SECTION, "HIGH-PERFORMANCE HOME" MEANS A NEW RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE CURRENT VERSION OF:

(1) THE **BRONZE** <u>SILVER</u> RATING OF THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL'S 700 NATIONAL GREEN BUILDING STANDARDS; OR

(II) (2) THE SILVER RATING OF THE U.S. GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL'S LEED (LEADERSHIP IN ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN) FOR HOMES RATING SYSTEM.

(2) (B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), AND (C) OF THIS SECTION AND IN ADDITION TO THE OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE RELATING TO BUILDING PERFORMANCE STANDARDS, THE <u>THE</u> DEPARTMENT SHALL ENCOURAGE, THROUGH REGULATION, POLICY, OR

LEGISLATION, THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES IN THE STATE THAT ARE HIGH–PERFORMANCE HOMES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
