Chapter 570

(Senate Bill 977)

AN ACT concerning

Freedom of Speech - Picketing at a Funeral - Distance

FOR the purpose of altering the distance within which a person is prohibited from engaging in picketing activities at a funeral, burial, memorial service, or funeral procession; and generally relating to picketing at a funeral, burial, memorial service, or funeral procession.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Criminal Law

10-205.

(c) A person may not engage in picketing activity within [100] **500** feet of a funeral, burial, memorial service, or funeral procession that is targeted at one or more persons attending the funeral, burial, memorial service, or funeral procession.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
