JCS will be moving from leased property to property owned by The Associated. The project will provide JCS with 12,500 square feet to allow for providing more services at a much more desirable location that should attract many more persons in need of services in the community and help in reducing the burden on the State. The remaining 12,500 square feet will be used by the JCC to allow expansion of its community agenda as a center for programming and other services of the general Owings Mills community it serves.
