	<b>10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b> (Limit Length to Visible area)						
People's Community Health Centers, Inc. is a Federally Qualified Health Center that provides healthcare services to patients at seven sites in Baltimore City and three sites in Anne Arundel County. Its mission is to provide quality comprehensive primary healthcare to all, regardless of ability to pay. PCHC is a pioneer of the patient-centered "medical home" model, providing a full range of cost-effective healthcare services. Six years ago, PCHC opened a health center in a small townhouse in Severn in the poorest area of Anne Arundel County, where residents suffer high rates of obesity, infant mortality, teen pregnancy, and HIV prevalence, a situation costing residents their lives and the state of Maryland the high costs associated with chronic disease. This bond requests funds for plans and specifications now necessary for this project, a health center and community center on Reece Road that will meet the pent-up need for healthcare in this community. Through partnership with a provider of quality afterschool, job-readiness, and athletic programs, the project will also contribute to improved educational outcomes and provide the community hope for a brighter future.							

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Reece Road Community Health Center will be developed and owned by People's. The project has grown in scope since last year through expanded partnership with the County Executive's Office, Arundel County Development Services, and the Board of Education, which unanimously endorses the project. The Center is now to break ground on 10.6 acres on Reece Road, owned by AACBOE and in the process of being transferred to the County and then to People's (2011). The building will be 30,000 square feet, with approximately half devoted to the Federally Qualified Health Center (including urgent care) and half to the community center. The project will enable the provision of health services to 6000 patients annually-- including many veterans--in this community close to Fort Meade now suffering from high levels of obesity, infant mortality, HIV prevalence, and the documented need for increased mental health and substance abuse programs. The community center will be operated by an organization with expertise in providing programs in mentoring, recreation, tutoring, job preparation, and STEM education, serving hundreds of children and youth who currently have nowhere to go. Seventy-five construction jobs and more than fifty permanent jobs will be created.

## 28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)

People's is in receipt of a \$250,000 general bond from the Maryland legislature awarded in 2010 for construction and requiring a two-year timeframe. This award catalyzed other funding and the commitment of the Board of Education and the Anne Arundel County Executive's office to facilitate all steps necessary for the transfer of the 10.6 acre parcel of land adjacent to the Van Bokkelen Elementary School to People's without cost. The Governor has included within the FY2012 budget \$1.6 million for the health center side of the project-- an FQHC bond.

Whereas People's had raised and contributed considerable funds to the project plan at 1135 Reece Road, use of the land across the street will allow for greater benefit to the community, as it will increase the space for the community center portion greatly and provide space for recreational and fitness opportunities critical in an area where children are at a very high risk for obesity. Children will be able to easily walk to the new site, facilitating increased access to health services as well for individuals previously difficult to reach. The increased level of partnership with Anne Arundel County brings a more robust level of planning and execution of the project. The center will provide an anchor of safety and wellness within a community that has waited a long time.

However, funds are now needed for a new architectural/engineering plan for the 1130 Reece Road property in order to complete the project in a timely fashion. The need for this project is widely recognized. People's already serves this community and extraordinary support for the project at every level has been communicated, with six hundred community support letters provided by residents and the enthusiastic support of the County Executive's office, Anne Arundel County Development Services, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Anne Arundel County Department of Health, the Van Bokkelen School, the Baltimore Washington Medical Center, the Board of Education, the faith community, the County Council, the Maryland legislature and federal officials, including Congressmen Ruppersberger and Sarbanes and Senators Mikulski and Cardin. Virtually every health and educational indicator is expected to improve through building this project.
