FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 245 (Howard County Delegation)

Economic Matters Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer, Wine and Liquor Tasting License Ho. Co. 5-11

This bill creates a beer, wine, and liquor tasting license (BWLT) in Howard County. A BWLT license may only be issued to a holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license (BWL). The annual license fee is \$100. The bill also increases, from 14% to 15.5%, the maximum alcohol content of wine that may be served under a beer and wine tasting (BWT) license.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2011.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Howard County license fee revenues increase by approximately \$5,900 annually. County expenditures are not affected.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Bill Summary: A BWLT license authorizes the on-premises consumption of the following alcoholic beverages for tasting or sampling purposes only:

• wine in a quantity not exceeding one ounce from each given brand and four ounces from all brands to any one person in a day;

- beer in a quantity not exceeding three ounces from each given brand and eight ounces from all brands to any one person in a day; or
- liquor in a quantity not exceeding one-fourth ounce from each given brand and one ounce from all brands to any one person in a day.

Current Law: A BWT license authorizes a holder to allow the on-premises consumption of wine and beer in specified quantities. A Class BWT license may only be issued to a holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor (BWL) license or a Class A beer and wine (BW) license. The annual fee for a BWT licenses is \$100, which is in addition to the Class A annual license fee.

Local Fiscal Effect: In fiscal 2010, Howard County issued 59 Class A BWL licenses. If each licensee applies for, and receives a BWLT license, county license fee revenues increase by \$5,900 annually.
