10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)								

A Step Forward, Incorporated (ASF) is a non profit, community based organization that has been in existence since 2001. We provide support services to homeless men, women and youth who are suffering with the disease of addiction and other related issues such as co-occurring mental health disorders, physical disorders, unemployment, underemployment, financial deprivation, illiteracy, recent incarceration and family disassociation.

Over the years, our agency has found itself working more frequently with veteran men and women. As we work with this population in assisting them with obtaining their treatment goals, we found it to be more challenging in getting assistance for our veteran women. That there was an increased need for housing and support services for these women. Over the past two years, our executive director has done extensive research in the area of veteran women and the disparities that they face. For these reasons, we are building our capacity to increase services that will meet the specific needs of our homeless veteran women population, especially those with children.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

A Step Forward looks to turn a 3,200 square foot vacant property into a home and community service center for 16 veteran women (individual and with children). The green model facility will provide a safe house that is conducive to family recovery. Project will begin with demolition. Interior walls will be removed with all floor framing mechanical, electrical and plumbing. Site work will include back field and grading of rear yard for purpose of parking lot. Exterior structure will include but not limit the repairing of all damaged wood. Repointing of bricks, repairing of front stairs and installation of rear landing and stairs. Thermo and moisture protection will include replacement of roof, gutter and down spouts and installation to proper levels. Exterior doors and windows will be repaired/replaced. Elevator will be installed to meet disability codes. Interior repairs will include framing, partitioning, sub floors and ceilings along with new drywall priming and painting. All electrical, mechanical and plumbing systems will be upgraded to code. Will also include new water main from meter. New furniture and appliances will be installed upon completion of construction. We will also add new security and telephone systems.
