House Bill 1315 Judiciary (Howard County Delegation)

Judicial Proceedings

Howard County - Orphans' Court Sessions Ho. Co. 9-11

This bill requires the Orphans' Court for Howard County to determine when to hold its sessions for the transaction of business.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2011.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practice.

Local Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practice.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Unless a different time is specified in statute or prescribed by local law, the Orphans' Court must be held on the second Tuesday of February, April, June, August, October, and December, and more often if required.

Background: This bill allows the court the flexibility to set its own schedule as well as to close during inclement weather or in case of other emergencies and remain in compliance with State law.

An orphans' court hears all contested matters regarding a decedent's estate, including validity of wills and legal questions involving transfers of property. The court also

supervises estates that are probated judicially; approves accounts, awards of personal representatives' commissions, and attorney's fees in all estates; and has concurrent jurisdiction with the circuit courts in the guardianship of minors and their property.
