10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)				
<p>Since its founding in 1977, NCIA, a 501(c)(3) corporation, has been working on behalf of intellectually disabled adults and children and other disadvantaged populations in Maryland. NCIA employs over 600 and its headquarters has been in the Woodlawn area of Baltimore County since the late 1980's.</p> <p>The Career Development Center currently supports over 150 adults with intellectual disabilities for the purposes of prearing and supporting them for community work placement. The program has grown significantly in the past two years and the current facility is not viable or cost effective to support the adults in the program. Additionally, the size constraints limits our ability to accept new adults into the program. A new Career Development Center designed to support an increase in the number of adults served is necessary.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Career Development Center (the "Center") is a one and a half story building of approximately 19,000 square feet. The Center will be an adult career development program for approximately 225 intellectually disabled adults, a 50% increase in the number of adults currently participating in our program. The adults participating in the program will receive individualized training and support necessary to prepare for community work placement. The new Center will include administrative offices, training, and conference rooms, three regular size classrooms and one large classroom, a fitness center, an art resource activity room, a computer training resource room, an interior atrium and food court area.

With the increased capacity the Center will increase its staff members from 134 to 196 employees an increase of 46%. Building the new Center will also provide needed construction jobs in the community for 9 months (the projected construction time).
