The current concession area is too small and does not face the field. The proposed concession stand will face the field and will include bathroom facilities for men, women and handicapped persons. We will be able to eliminate the port-a-pots that are currently being used. A new concession stand will allow us to raise more money for the replacement of the grandstands and pressbox which is part of our renovation project. Once completed the stadium will be able to handle numerous county, regional and state athletic events.
