# **Economic Development - Task Force on Industrial Job Creation in Baltimore County**

This bill establishes a Task Force on Industrial Job Creation in Baltimore County. The task force must submit its preliminary findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 31, 2011, and its final report by June 1, 2012.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2011, and terminates June 30, 2012.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Staff support and expense reimbursements for task force members are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing resources of the Department of Business and Economic Development (DBED). Revenues are not affected.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

### **Analysis**

**Bill Summary:** The task force must:

- determine the causes of the loss of employment opportunities within Baltimore County in industry, ship building and repair, and businesses that supply industry;
- identify current State policies on job creation in these industries to determine their effectiveness; and

make recommendations, including legislative and policy proposals, regarding
ways the State can encourage new employers to locate in Baltimore County, retain
existing employers in the county, encourage employers that have left to return to
the county, and encourage employers to maintain or grow the number of
employees within the county.

The task force is required to consider relevant findings of the Maryland Economic Development Commission and the Governor's Commission on Small Businesses.

A member of the task force may not receive compensation for serving on the task force but is entitled to reimbursement for expenses. DBED must staff the task force.
