<p>The Capitol Heights Seat Pleasant Boys and Girls Club is a member club of the Prince George's County Boys &amp; Girls Club which is a private, non-profit corporation incorporated under the statutes of the State of Maryland and is governed by a Board of Directors. The Club provides Prince George's County youth opportunities to participate in many activities sponsored and conducted by 33 member clubs located throughout the county.</p>				

**11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit Length to Visible area)

The purpose of the project is to help the youth of low- and moderate-income households overcome barriers to involvement and participation in activities encouraging self-esteem, achievement, discipline, and leadership.

The project has two (2) objectives:

- 1) to purchase a fuel-efficient passenger van to provide transportation to programs and events for youth lacking the means to consistently participate in activities most beneficial to positive character development and citizenry; and
- 2) to equip facilities for the specific and ongoing use of the CHBGC membership and the Capitol Heights and Seat Pleasant communities. Funding will be used to purchase a variety of capital improvements and upgrades including scoreboards, stands, turf field and other equipment necessary for sports, fitness, and recreational events and programming under the direction of CHBGC and its partners.
