11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

30 years of salt water, humidity in a concrete environment has caused considerable deterioration to occur. In order to maintain the viability of the National Aquarium as a key tourist destination in Maryland, various infrastructure components of the facility must be updated, renovated and/or replaced. These projects will also bring the aging facility into compliance with current State codes. The National Aquarium has proposed as multi-phase/year effort to accomplish this goal. During FY2012, the National Aquarium proposes various infrastructure projects, the main one being the renovation/replacement of the central exhibit: The Ray Tray. This exhibit is central to the Aquarium's original building and is the exhibit that the public first encounters upon entering the Aquarium. Deterioration of the Ray Tray has caused failures in the concrete structure requiring redesign and replacement.
