1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Transportation Authority – Audit Statements Available Online**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transportation Authority to make audit
4 statements publicly available on its Internet site, including audit statements
5 relating to each transportation facilities project throughout the entire existence
6 of each transportation facilities project; defining a certain term; and generally
7 relating to making audit statements of the Maryland Transportation Authority
8 available online.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Transportation**

22 4–101.

23 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (b) "Authority" means the Maryland Transportation Authority.

2 (h) "Transportation facilities project" includes:

3 (1) The Susquehanna River Bridge, the Harry W. Nice Memorial
4 Potomac River Bridge, the William Preston Lane, Jr. Memorial Chesapeake Bay
5 Bridge and parallel Chesapeake Bay Bridge, the Baltimore Harbor Tunnel, the Fort
6 McHenry Tunnel, the Francis Scott Key Bridge, and the John F. Kennedy Memorial
7 Highway, together with their appurtenant causeways, approaches, interchanges,
8 entrance plazas, toll stations, and service facilities;

9 (2) A vehicle parking facility located in a priority funding area as
10 defined in § 5-7B-02 of the State Finance and Procurement Article;

11 (3) Any other project for transportation facilities that the Authority
12 authorizes to be acquired or constructed; and

13 (4) Any additions, improvements, or enlargements to any of these
14 projects, whenever authorized.

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "AUDIT STATEMENT" MEANS ANY DOCUMENT
17 CONTAINING A FORMAL EXAMINATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OR
18 FINANCIAL CONDITION OF THE AUTHORITY OR OF ANY TRANSPORTATION
19 FACILITIES PROJECT.

20 (B) THE AUTHORITY SHALL MAKE AUDIT STATEMENTS PUBLICLY
21 AVAILABLE ON ITS INTERNET SITE, INCLUDING AUDIT STATEMENTS RELATING
22 TO EACH TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES PROJECT THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE
23 EXISTENCE OF EACH TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES PROJECT.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 June 1, 2012.
