- FOR the purpose of altering the boundaries of the residence districts for the
 Montgomery County Board of Education; repealing a provision of law relating to
 the date when certain reapportioned districts become effective; making this Act
 an emergency measure; and generally relating to the residence districts for the
 Montgomery County Board of Education.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 3–901.
- 18 (a) (1) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (2) "Elected member" means 1 of the 7 elected and voting members of 2 the Montgomery County Board or a member appointed to fill a vacancy of 1 of these 7 3 members.

"Board of Education District" means a geographic area of 4 (3)Montgomery County in which an elected member of the Montgomery County Board of $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Education must be a legal resident. The geographic area of each district is described in 7subsection (f) of this section. Each district shall be substantially equal in population, 8 and the districts shall be reapportioned on the basis of each decennial census of the 9 United States. [Reapportioned districts shall become effective for the term of office 10 commencing after the first regular primary election held at least 15 months after the official report on population is received by the State from the Bureau of the Census.] 11

 - (b) The Montgomery County Board consists of:

13 (1) 5 elected members, each of whom resides in a different board ofeducation district;

(2) 2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and

16 (3) 1 student member.

17 (c) An elected member of the county board shall be a registered voter of 18 Montgomery County.

19 (d) Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general 20 election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section.

(e) (1) The student member shall be a bona fide resident of Montgomery
County and a regularly enrolled junior or senior year student from a Montgomery
County public high school.

(2) The nomination and election process shall be as agreed on by the
county board and the Montgomery County region of the Maryland Association of
Student Councils. This agreement shall include a process by which to replace one or
both of the final candidates if they are unable to proceed in the election. Any student
enrolled in a middle or high school in the Montgomery County public schools may:

(i) Nominate a student member candidate;

30 (ii) Vote for delegates from the student's school, who in turn
31 vote in a nominating convention to reduce to 2 the number of candidates for student
32 board member if there are 3 or more candidates; and

33 (iii) Vote directly for 1 of the 2 remaining student board member34 candidates.

1 (3) The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes in the 2 direct election shall become the alternate student member. The alternate shall serve if 3 the student member is unable to complete his elected term.

4 (4) Except as provided in paragraphs (5), (6), and (7) of this 5 subsection, the student member has the same rights and privileges of an elected 6 member.

7 (5) Unless invited to attend by the affirmative vote of a majority of the 8 county board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to:

(i) Hearings held under $\S 6-202(a)$ of this article; or

10

(ii) Collective bargaining.

11 (6) As provided in paragraph (7) of this subsection, the student 12 member shall vote on all matters except those relating to:

- 13 (i) $\S 6-202(a)$ of this article;
- 14 (ii) Collective bargaining;
- 15 (iii) Capital and operating budgets; and
- 16 (iv) School closings, reopenings, and boundaries.

17 (7) On a majority vote of the elected members, the board may 18 determine, on a case by case basis, whether a matter under consideration is covered by 19 the exclusionary provisions listed in paragraph (6) of this subsection.

(f) (1) Each elected member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on December 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies. The terms of elected members are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on the county board as of July 1, 1978 so that 4 members are elected in gubernatorial election years and 3 members are elected in presidential election years.

(2) Elected members of the county board shall be elected by the voters
 of the entire county.

(3) (i) Of the 3 members elected in 1992 and every 4 years
thereafter, 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 2 and 1 shall reside in Board
of Education District 4. The third member may reside in any part of the county.

30 (ii) Of the 4 members elected in 1990 and every 4 years
31 thereafter, 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 1, 1 shall reside in Board of
32 Education District 3, and 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 5. The fourth
33 member may reside in any part of the county.
