AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 390

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Reznik" and substitute "Reznik, Afzali, Boteler, Cardin, Howard, Ivey, and F. Turner"; in line 2, strike "Libraries – Maryland" and substitute "Task Force to Study the Establishment of a"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through the second "library" in line 7 and substitute "creating the Task Force to Study the Establishment of a Deaf Culture Digital Library; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act"; in line 8, strike "the establishment of"; in the same line, strike "Maryland" and substitute "Task Force to Study the Establishment of a"; and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 14, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 13 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

"SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Establishment of a Deaf Culture Library.
 - (b) The Task Force consists of the following 11 members:

- (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (3) the State Superintendent of Education, or the Superintendent's designee; and
 - (4) the following six members, appointed by the Governor:
- (i) one representative of the Division of Library Development and Services in the State Department of Education;
- (ii) one representative of the Governor's Office of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing;
 - (iii) one representative of the Maryland Library Association; and
- (iv) three representatives of the deaf community or of deaf organizations in the State.
 - (c) The Governor shall designate the chair of the Task Force.
 - (d) The State Department of Education shall provide staff for the Task Force.
 - (e) A member of the Task Force:
 - (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(f) The Task Force shall:

- (1) study the establishment of a Deaf Culture Digital Library, including potential funding sources for the library through a public-private partnership or the establishment of a friends of the library organization; and
- (2) <u>make recommendations regarding the coordination of a Deaf</u>

 <u>Culture Digital Library to educate individuals about deaf cultures in the United</u>

 <u>States and other countries, including reference material and links to other resources.</u>
- (g) On or before December 1, 2012, the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 15, strike "October" and substitute "July"; and in the same line, after "2012." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year, and at the end of June 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
