AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 150, AS AMENDED  
(First Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

On page 118, in Amendment No. 84, under:

Heading: AID TO EDUCATION

Program: R00A02.01

Entitled: State Share of Foundation Program

In line 10, after “Fund” insert “. Further provided that \$830,818 of this appropriation made for the State Share of Foundation Program shall not be spent for that purpose and instead may only be transferred to the Guaranteed Tax Base program if additional State funds are necessary to provide aid under § 5-210 of the Education Article. Any funds not expended for this restricted purpose may not be transferred by budget amendment or otherwise to any other purpose and shall revert to the General Fund.”.

On page 215, after line 30, insert:

“SECTION 45. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the following appropriations contained in Section 1 of this Act are reduced by \$1,226,384,600 as follows:

SECTION 46. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal 2013, no  
funds may be transferred from the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve  
Fund to the General Fund.”.
