AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1401

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike the second “Education – ” and substitute “Education”; in line 3, strike, “Monitoring”; in line 7, after the first “certain” insert “oral health”; in the same line, strike “and” and substitute a comma; in line 8, after “education” insert “, and submit a certain summary to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; requiring the State Board of Education to encourage certain county boards of education to incorporate certain lessons into certain curriculum”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 8 down through “intervals;” in line 10; and after line 15, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Education

Section 7-411.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2008 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 12, strike “(A)”; in line 18, after “EDUCATION” insert “, INCLUDING ORAL DISEASE PREVENTION AND DENTAL HEALTH PROMOTION,”; in line 19, strike “AND”; and in line 21, after “EDUCATION” insert “; AND

(3) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2015, AND EVERY 5 YEARS THEREAFTER, SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A SUMMARY OF THE INFORMATION REPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT DURING THE CERTIFICATION OF THE HEALTH EDUCATION STATE CURRICULUM”;

(Over)

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 5 through 10, inclusive, and substitute:

“7-411.1.

The State Board shall encourage the county boards to incorporate age-appropriate lessons on dating violence, **ORAL DISEASE PREVENTION, AND DENTAL HEALTH PROMOTION** into the county boards’ health education curriculum.”.
