On page 2, in line 12, strike "(A)"; in line 18, after "EDUCATION" insert ", INCLUDING ORAL DISEASE PREVENTION AND DENTAL HEALTH PROMOTION,"; in line 19, strike "AND"; and in line 21, after "EDUCATION" insert "; AND

(3) On or before December 1, 2015, and every 5 years thereafter, submit to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly a summary of the Information Reported by the Department to the State Superintendent during the certification of the Health Education State Curriculum";
