AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1412, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments (HB1412/465067/1), in Amendment No. 1, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 5 down through "board;" in line 7 and substitute "requiring the State Board to grant a rebasing waiver under certain circumstances;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 12 of the bill, in line 11, after "(III)" insert "1. THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF A REBASING WAIVER IN THIS PARAGRAPH DO NOT APPLY TO A COUNTY THAT QUALIFIES FOR A REBASING WAIVER UNDER PARAGRAPH (11) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

On page 5 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments, in line 2 of Amendment No. 5, after "(11)" insert:

- "(I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "5-YEAR MOVING AVERAGE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN PARAGRAPH (10) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (II) THE STATE BOARD SHALL GRANT A REBASING WAIVER
 OF AT LEAST 2% OF THE REQUIRED LOCAL APPROPRIATION IF THE STATE
 BOARD FINDS THAT:
- 1. AT LEAST TWO OF THE FOLLOWING ECONOMIC CONDITIONS APPLY TO THE COUNTY:

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A. THE COUNTY'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IS EITHER

1.2% GREATER THAN THE STATEWIDE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE OR 1.2% GREATER

THAN THE COUNTY'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN THE PRIOR YEAR:

- B. THE COUNTY'S LATEST ANNUAL REASSESSMENT YIELDED A NET DECLINE IN PROPERTY VALUES FOR THE AREA ASSESSED; OR
- C. THE COUNTY'S INCOME TAX COLLECTIONS FOR THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR ARE AT LEAST 10% BELOW THE COLLECTIONS OF THE PRIOR YEAR; AND

2. THE COUNTY'S:

- A. INCOME TAX RATE IS AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY § 10-106 OF THE TAX GENERAL ARTICLE;
- B. EDUCATION EFFORT IN THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR IS GREATER THAN THE STATEWIDE 5-YEAR MOVING AVERAGE FOR EDUCATION EFFORT; AND
- C. PER PUPIL LOCAL APPROPRIATION IS AT LEAST 10% GREATER THAN THE STATEWIDE AVERAGE PER PUPIL LOCAL APPROPRIATION.
