AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 132

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “specifying” in line 4 down through “State” in line 5 and substitute “requiring a nonresident pharmacy to have a pharmacist on staff who is licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy and designated as the pharmacist responsible for providing certain services to certain patients”; in line 6, strike “laws” and substitute “requirements”; strike beginning with “is” in line 10 down through “records” in line 12 and substitute “is required to refer certain patients to a certain pharmacist; altering the scope of disciplinary actions to which a nonresident pharmacy is subject”; and strike in their entirety lines 19 through 28, inclusive.

On page 2, in line 3, strike “12-403(d), (e), and (g)” and substitute “12-403(e) and (g)”; and in line 8, strike “12-403(f)” and substitute “12-403(d) and (f)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 20, inclusive; in line 21, strike “hold” and substitute “:

(1) HOLD”;

in line 22, after “Board” insert “;AND

(2) HAVE A PHARMACIST ON STAFF WHO IS:

(I) LICENSED BY THE BOARD; AND

(II) DESIGNATED AS THE PHARMACIST RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES TO PATIENTS IN THE STATE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 3, strike “**SUBJECT TO**” and substitute “**NOTWITHSTANDING**”; strike beginning with “**THIS**” in line 5 down through “**TITLE**” in line 6 and substitute “**THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B)(2), (7) THROUGH (12), AND (19)**”; strike line 25 in its entirety; in line 26, strike “**(II)**” and substitute “**(I)**”; after line 26, insert:

“(II) IS REQUIRED TO REFER PATIENTS IN THE STATE TO THE RESPONSIBLE PHARMACIST LICENSED IN THE STATE, AS APPROPRIATE;”;

and in line 28, strike the bracket.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 2, strike the bracket; and in line 15, strike “subsection” and substitute “**SUBTITLE**”.
