AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 774

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “specifying” in line 3 down through “a” in line 4 and substitute “clarifying the form of document that may be used to create a certain statutory form”; in line 4, after the semicolon insert “providing that a document substantially in the form of a certain statutory form in effect on the date the document is executed shall continue to have a certain meaning and effect notwithstanding enactment of certain legislation;”; in line 8, after “authority” insert “to make gifts to certain persons.”; and in line 9, after “plans” insert a comma.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 23 through 28, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) A DOCUMENT SUBSTANTIALLY IN ONE OF THE FORMS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBTITLE IN EFFECT ON THE DATE THE DOCUMENT IS EXECUTED SHALL CONTINUE TO HAVE THE MEANING AND EFFECT PRESCRIBED BY THIS TITLE, NOTWITHSTANDING ENACTMENT OF LEGISLATION ALTERING THAT STATUTORY FORM AFTER THE DATE THE DOCUMENT IS EXECUTED.”
