# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 774 (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "specifying" in line 3 down through "a" in line 4 and substitute "clarifying the form of document that may be used to create a certain statutory form"; in line 4, after the semicolon insert "providing that a document substantially in the form of a certain statutory form in effect on the date the document is executed shall continue to have a certain meaning and effect notwithstanding enactment of certain legislation;"; in line 8, after "authority" insert "to make gifts to certain persons,"; and in line 9, after "plans" insert a comma.

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 23 through 28, inclusive, and substitute:

**(B)** <u>A DOCUMENT SUBSTANTIALLY IN ONE OF THE FORMS SET FORTH IN</u> <u>THIS SUBTITLE IN EFFECT ON THE DATE THE DOCUMENT IS EXECUTED SHALL</u> <u>CONTINUE TO HAVE THE MEANING AND EFFECT PRESCRIBED BY THIS TITLE,</u> <u>NOTWITHSTANDING ENACTMENT OF LEGISLATION ALTERING THAT STATUTORY</u> <u>FORM AFTER THE DATE THE DOCUMENT IS EXECUTED.</u>".
