AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "- Penalties"; strike beginning with "knowingly" in line 3 down through "term" in line 15 and substitute "<u>being in or on the motor vehicle</u> <u>of another with the intent to commit theft of property that is on the motor vehicle;</u> <u>establishing that a certain penalty applies to a violation of this Act</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 16 through 20, inclusive, and substitute:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article - Criminal Law</u> <u>Section 6-206</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2002 Volume and 2011 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 24 on page 1 through line 14 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>6–206.</u>

(a) <u>A person may not possess a burglar's tool with the intent to use or allow</u> the use of the burglar's tool in the commission of a crime involving the breaking and entering of a motor vehicle.

(b) <u>A person may not be in or on the motor vehicle of another with the intent</u> to commit theft of the motor vehicle or property that is in **OR ON** the motor vehicle.

(c) <u>A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, shall be</u> <u>considered a rogue and vagabond, and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not</u> <u>exceeding 3 years.</u>".
