<u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 797</u> (First Reading File Bill)

<u>AMENDMENT NO. 1</u>

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike beginning with "Delegates" down through "Wood" and substitute "<u>Baltimore County Delegation</u>"; in line 3, strike "Prohibition" and substitute "<u>Penalty</u>"; strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 4 down through "violation;" in line 11; in line 11, strike "for the issuance of" and substitute "<u>that a</u> <u>person standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore County</u> who solicits money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle without a certain <u>permit is subject to</u>"; in line 12, strike "to" and substitute "<u>as</u>"; in the same line, strike "; providing" and substitute "<u>and to</u>"; in line 13, strike "defining a certain term;"; strike beginning with "restrictions" in line 13 down through "for" in line 14 and substitute "<u>penalties for</u>"; and in line 14, after "donations" insert "<u>without a permit while</u> <u>standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore County</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "(1)" in line 1 down through "VIOLATION." in line 29; in line 30, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike "(5)".

On page 3, in lines 1, 14, 17, 23, and 29, in each instance, strike the brackets; and in the same lines, strike "(6)", "(7)", "(8)", "(9)", and "(10)", respectively.

On page 4, in lines 1, 2, 4, and 7, in each instance, strike the brackets; and in the same lines, strike "(11)", "(12)", "(13)", and "(14)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 8, insert:

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"(11) <u>A PERSON STANDING IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR</u> <u>INTERSECTION WHO SOLICITS MONEY OR DONATIONS FROM THE OCCUPANT OF</u> <u>A VEHICLE WITHOUT A PERMIT REQUIRED BY A RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE</u> <u>ENACTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, IS SUBJECT TO:</u>

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(I) IF IT IS THE OFFENDER'S FIRST VIOLATION, A WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A PERMIT UNDER THE RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE ENACTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION; AND

(II) IF IT IS THE OFFENDER'S SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A PENALTY UNDER § 27-101 OF THIS ARTICLE.".
