AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 797

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike beginning with “Delegates” down through “Wood” and substitute “Baltimore County Delegation”; in line 3, strike “Prohibition” and substitute “Penalty”; strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 4 down through “violation;” in line 11; in line 11, strike “for the issuance of” and substitute “that a person standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore County who solicits money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle without a certain permit is subject to”; in line 12, strike “to” and substitute “as”; in the same line, strike “; providing” and substitute “and to”; in line 13, strike “defining a certain term;”; strike beginning with “restrictions” in line 13 down through “for” in line 14 and substitute “penalties for”; and in line 14, after “donations” insert “without a permit while standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Baltimore County”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “**(1)**” in line 1 down through “**VIOLATION.**” in line 29; in line 30, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “**(5)**”.

On page 3, in lines 1, 14, 17, 23, and 29, in each instance, strike the brackets; and in the same lines, strike “**(6)**”, “**(7)**”, “**(8)**”, “**(9)**”, and “**(10)**”, respectively.

On page 4, in lines 1, 2, 4, and 7, in each instance, strike the brackets; and in the same lines, strike “**(11)**”, “**(12)**”, “**(13)**”, and “**(14)**”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 8, insert:

(Over)

“(11) A PERSON STANDING IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION WHO SOLICITS MONEY OR DONATIONS FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE WITHOUT A PERMIT REQUIRED BY A RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE ENACTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, IS SUBJECT TO:

(I) IF IT IS THE OFFENDER’S FIRST VIOLATION, A WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A PERMIT UNDER THE RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE ENACTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION; AND

(II) IF IT IS THE OFFENDER’S SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A PENALTY UNDER § 27-101 OF THIS ARTICLE.”.
