AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 867

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Senator Conway" and substitute "Senators Conway, Dyson, Montgomery, Rosapepe, and Simonaire"; in lines 2 and 3, strike "- Certification and Monitoring"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "year;" in line 6; in line 7, after the first "certain" insert "oral health"; in the same line, strike "and" and substitute a comma; in line 8, after "education" insert ", and submit a certain summary to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; requiring the State Board of Education to encourage certain county boards of education to incorporate certain lessons into certain curriculum"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 8 down through "year;" in line 9; and in line 18, strike "7-401(a)" and substitute "7-411.1".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "(A)" in line 7 down through "(B)" in line 12; in line 13, after "EDUCATION" insert ", INCLUDING ORAL DISEASE PREVENTION AND DENTAL HEALTH PROMOTION,"; in line 14, strike "AND"; strike beginning with "AS" in line 16 down through "SECTION" in line 17 and substitute "; AND

**(3) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2012, AND EVERY 5 YEARS THEREAFTER, SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A SUMMARY OF THE INFORMATION REPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT DURING THE CERTIFICATION OF THE HEALTH EDUCATION STATE CURRICULUM**";

strike in their entirety lines 18 through 30, inclusive; and after line 30, insert:

“7-411.1.

The State Board shall encourage the county boards to incorporate age–  
appropriate lessons on dating violence, **ORAL DISEASE PREVENTION, AND DENTAL  
HEALTH PROMOTION** into the county boards’ health education curriculum.”.
