AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 208
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “plan;” insert “requiring a county to address, in a certain recycling plan, a method for implementing a reporting requirement for certain recyclable materials under certain circumstances;”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 12 down through “councils;” in line 16 and substitute “authorizing a county to require certain property owners, managers, and councils to report to the county on recycling activities;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 15, strike “AND” and substitute:

“(13) IF APPLICABLE, A METHOD FOR IMPLEMENTING A REPORTING REQUIREMENT FOR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS GENERATED AT APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND CONDOMINIUMS THAT CONTAIN 10 OR MORE DWELLING UNITS; AND”;

and in line 16, strike “**(13)**” and substitute “**(14)**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 6, after “A” insert “COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS OF A”; strike in their entirety lines 14 through 21, inclusive; in line 22, strike “**(II)**”; and strike beginning with “A” in line 29 down through “COUNTY” in line 34 and substitute:

“(2) A COUNTY MAY REQUIRE A PROPERTY OWNER OR MANAGER OF AN APARTMENT BUILDING OR A COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS OF A CONDOMINIUM THAT PROVIDES FOR RECYCLING FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE DWELLING UNITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION

(Over)

TO REPORT TO THE COUNTY ON RECYCLING ACTIVITIES IN A MANNER
DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, in line 6, strike "SUBSECTIONS" and substitute "SUBSECTION"; and in the same line, strike "AND" and substitute "OR".
