AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1098  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Recycling” and substitute “Prohibition”; in line 3, strike “Lumber”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 4 down through “term;” in line 8 and substitute “prohibiting the Department of the Environment and Baltimore City from initiating an enforcement action or civil suit against a certain facility under a certain circumstance.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 19 on page 1 through line 10 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

**“THE DEPARTMENT AND BALTIMORE CITY MAY NOT INITIATE AN ENFORCEMENT ACTION OR CIVIL SUIT AGAINST A FACILITY IN BALTIMORE CITY THAT ACCEPTS FOR RECYCLING CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS THAT CONTAINS A MIXTURE OF CONCRETE, BRICK, AND LUMBER, IF THE LUMBER DOES NOT EXCEED 10% BY VOLUME OF THE MIXTURE OF CONCRETE, BRICK, AND LUMBER.”.**
