AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 119, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB0119/642715/5), in Amendment No. 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 11 down through “policy” in line 15 and substitute “requiring the Police Training Commission and the Maryland Statistical Analysis Center (MJAC), in consultation with the Administrative Office of the Courts, to develop a certain format for the recording of certain data and to develop certain procedures relating to the compilation and submission of certain data on or before a certain date; requiring the Police Training Commission to develop certain guidelines for certain data collection and a certain model policy relating to citations”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 20 down through “comply;” in line 23.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 8 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB0119/642715/5), in line 19 of Amendment No. 3, after “**(B)**” insert “**THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION AND THE MARYLAND STATISTICAL ANALYSIS CENTER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, SHALL DEVELOP A FORMAT FOR THE EFFICIENT RECORDING OF DATA REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.**”

(C)”;

and in the same line, strike “**THE**” and substitute “**ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2012, THE**”.

On page 9 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 3, strike beginning with “**A**” in line 1 down through “**(2)**” in line 4; in line 5, strike “**BY**”

(Over)

ITS OFFICERS” and substitute “UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION”; in line 6, after the semicolon insert “AND”; strike beginning with “(3)” in line 7 down through “(4)” in line 10 and substitute “(2)”; in lines 12, 14, and 16, strike “(G)”, “(C)”, and “(D)”, respectively, and substitute “(H)”, “(D)”, and “(E)”, respectively; strike beginning with “TO” in line 18 down through “OFFICER” in line 19 and substitute “ON THE MARYLAND UNIFORM CITATION FORM CONSISTENT WITH THE PROCEDURES DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION AND”; and in line 20, strike “(B)(1)” and substitute “(B)”.

On page 10 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 3, strike line 12 in its entirety and substitute:

“(F) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2012, THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION AND THE MARYLAND STATISTICAL ANALYSIS CENTER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, SHALL DEVELOP A PROCEDURE FOR:”;

in line 13, strike “COMPILE THE DATA DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF” and substitute “THE COMPILATION OF DATA REQUIRED TO BE COLLECTED UNDER”; and in line 15, strike “(B)(3)” and substitute “(B)”.

On page 11 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in line 1 of Amendment No. 3, strike “SUBMIT” and substitute “THE SUBMISSION OF”; in line 3, after “YEAR” insert “BEGINNING ON MARCH 1, 2014”; in lines 4, 6, and 12, strike “(F)”, “(E)”, and “(G)”, respectively, and substitute “(G)”, “(F)”, and “(H)”, respectively; in line 5, strike “OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES”; and in line 11, after “YEAR” insert “BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2014”.

On page 12 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in line 2 of Amendment No. 3, strike "**BY ITS OFFICERS**"; in line 3, strike "**(D)**" and substitute "**(E)**"; and strike beginning with "**(H)**" in line 6 down through "**ASSEMBLY.**" in line 18.
