AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 399

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 13, after “inspection;” insert “providing that an investigation of a cottage food business conducted under a certain provision of this Act may include sampling of a cottage food product for certain purposes; requiring the Department to adopt regulations to carry out this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 13, strike “AND”; in line 15, after “SUBTITLE” insert “AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND

(3) HAS ANNUAL SALES REVENUES OF AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000;

in line 16, strike “(1)”; in the same line, after “A” insert “NONHAZARDOUS”; in the same line, after the second “FOOD” insert “, AS SPECIFIED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT,”; strike beginning with “BY” in line 16 down through “BUSINESS” in line 17 and substitute “AT A FARMER’S MARKET OR PUBLIC EVENT”; in line 18, after “SUBTITLE” insert “AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT”; and strike in their entirety lines 19 and 20.

On page 5, after line 27, insert:

“(4) AN INVESTIGATION OF A COTTAGE FOOD BUSINESS CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY INCLUDE SAMPLING OF A COTTAGE FOOD PRODUCT TO DETERMINE IF THE COTTAGE FOOD PRODUCT IS MISBRANDED OR ADULTERATED.

(F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.
