AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 559

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 2 and 3, strike “Smoking in Vehicle Containing Young Child” and substitute “Allowing Child to Ride in Vehicle in Which Smoking Has Occurred”; strike beginning with “in” in line 4 down through “smoke” in line 6 and substitute “from allowing a child under a certain age to be a passenger in a motor vehicle if the driver knows or should know that smoking has occurred”; and in line 9, strike “prohibitions against” and substitute “children and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 22 through 24, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE MAY NOT ALLOW A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 8 YEARS TO BE A PASSENGER IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE IF THE DRIVER KNOWS OR SHOULD KNOW THAT SMOKING HAS OCCURRED IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE.”.
