BY adding to Article – Education Section 4–111.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2008 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 7-401 and 7-411.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2008 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement) SECTION 1.
