20 21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24	(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.		

- 1 (g) "Local license" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license 2 that is issued by a local board to provide electrical services as a master electrician.
- 3 (h) "Master electrician" means an individual who has the experience, 4 knowledge, and skill to provide electrical services in all aspects of the electrical trade, 5 in a manner that complies with applicable plans, specifications, codes, or law.
- 6 (k) "State license" means a license that is issued by the State Board to a master electrician.
- 8 6–313.
- 9 (A) THE STATE, A COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY 10 EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL AS AN ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR ONLY IF THE 11 INDIVIDUAL:
- 12 (1) HOLDS A STATE LICENSE OR LOCAL LICENSE, AS APPLICABLE; 13 OR
- 14 (2) PREVIOUSLY HELD WITHIN THE LAST 5 YEARS, A STATE LICENSE OR LOCAL LICENSE, AS APPLICABLE, THAT WAS NOT SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.
- [(a)] (B) An individual may not have any financial interest in any electrical business while employed by the State, a county, or a local government as an electrical inspector.
- 20 **[(b)] (C)** (1) On appointment or employment as an electrical inspector, 21 the individual:
- 22 (i) shall place the State license of the individual on inactive 23 status; and
- 24 (ii) except for the renewal fee, shall meet the inactive status 25 requirements of § 6–311 of this subtitle.
- 26 (2) The State Board may issue an electrical inspector identification card to an electrical inspector who has placed the State license on inactive status.
- 28 (3) The State Board may not charge a fee to issue the identification 29 card.
- 30 **[(c)] (D)** The State Board may change the status of an electrical inspector to individual inactive status, if the electrical inspector:

8	including paymen	t of the reactivation fee.	
9	SECTION	2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be	
10	construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have		
11	any effect on or application to any electrical inspector employed by the State, a county		
12	or a municipal con	rporation before the effective date of this Act.	
13	SECTION	3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect	
14	October 1, 2012.
