- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 6 (g) "Local license" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license 7 that is issued by a local board to provide electrical services as a master electrician.
- 8 (h) "Master electrician" means an individual who has the experience, 9 knowledge, and skill to provide electrical services in all aspects of the electrical trade, 10 in a manner that complies with applicable plans, specifications, codes, or law.
- 11 (k) "State license" means a license that is issued by the State Board to a 12 master electrician.
