## A BILL ENTITLED

14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18	SUBTITLE 8. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD.

20 21	(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.



- 1 (B) (1) "BAY TMDL" MEANS THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD
  2 (TMDL) FOR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE FEDERAL
  3 CLEAN WATER ACT BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ON
  4 DECEMBER 29, 2010.
- 5 (2) "BAY TMDL" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATION TO THE BAY 6 TMDL MADE BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.
- 7 (C) "FINAL NUTRIENT REDUCTION TARGET" MEANS THE NUMERIC 8 REDUCTIONS IN NITROGEN, PHOSPHORUS, AND SEDIMENT THAT THE STATE 9 MUST ACHIEVE BY 2025 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BAY TMDL.
- 10 (D) "PRELIMINARY NUTRIENT REDUCTION TARGET" MEANS THE
  11 NUMERIC REDUCTIONS IN NITROGEN, PHOSPHORUS, AND SEDIMENT THAT THE
  12 STATE MUST ACHIEVE BY 2017 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BAY TMDL, WHICH
  13 SHALL BE APPROXIMATELY 60% OF THE FINAL NUTRIENT REDUCTION TARGET.
- 14 (E) (1) "WIP" MEANS A STATE WATERSHED IMPLEMENTATION PLAN
  15 APPROVED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO
  16 IMPLEMENT THE BAY TMDL WITHIN THE STATE.
- 17 (2) "WIP" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATION MADE BY THE STATE TO 18 A WIP.

- THE STATE MAY NOT SUBMIT A DRAFT DOCUMENT TO THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR APPROVAL AS A WIP, OR SUBMIT A MODIFICATION TO A WIP, THAT CONTAINS A PLAN DESIGNED TO ACHIEVE THE PRELIMINARY NUTRIENT REDUCTION TARGET BEFORE 2017 OR THE FINAL NUTRIENT REDUCTION TARGET BEFORE 2025.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
