Vehicle Laws - Suspension or Revocation of Driver's License or Privilege to Drive - Fee for Reinstatement

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for reinstatement of a suspended license or $\mathbf{5}$ privilege to drive to pay a certain fee to the Motor Vehicle Administration; 6 establishing the amount of the fee an individual whose license or privilege to 7 drive has been revoked is required to pay on filing an application for a new 8 license or for reinstatement of the privilege to drive; establishing higher fees 9 under this Act for suspensions and revocations resulting from certain alcohol-related violations; making conforming changes; and generally relating 10 11 to drivers' licenses.

1 (2) IF THE SUSPENSION WAS RELATED TO A CONVICTION OF § 2 21–902 OF THIS ARTICLE OR A VIOLATION OF AN ALCOHOL RESTRICTION, \$100.

3 **(B)** On filing an application for a new license or for reinstatement of the 4 privilege to drive, any individual whose license or privilege to drive has been revoked, 5 shall pay to the Administration a fee [established by the Administration] **OF:**

(1) \$100; OR

7 (2) IF THE REVOCATION WAS RELATED TO A CONVICTION OF § 8 21–902 OF THIS ARTICLE OR A VIOLATION OF AN ALCOHOL RESTRICTION, \$150.

9 [(b) If the applicant's license was revoked as a result of a conviction under § 10 21–902 of this article or a violation of an alcohol restriction, the applicant shall pay a 11 fee established by the Administration in addition to the amount charged under 12 subsection (a) of this section.]
