4 FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions of law to authorize Sailwinds of Cambridge, Inc., instead of Sailwinds Park, Inc., to obtain and renew a certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 alcoholic beverages license in Dorchester County; requiring authorizing 7 Sailwinds Park of Cambridge, Inc. to distribute wristbands to certain individuals at certain events; prohibiting Sailwinds Park of Cambridge, Inc. 8 9 from serving alcoholic beverages to individuals who do not wear are not wearing 10 wristbands at certain events under certain circumstances; and generally 11 relating to prohibiting Sailwinds Park, Inc. from serving alcoholic beverages to individuals who do not wear wristbands limitations on serving alcoholic 12 beverages at events at Sailwinds of Cambridge, Inc. 13

5 6 7 8 9	(a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (n) of this section, a Class C beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. It authorizes the holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at any club, at the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises only.
10 11	(2) The annual fee for the license shall be paid to the local collecting agent before the license is issued, for distribution as provided.

14	(k) (1) This subsection applies only in Dorchester County.
15	(2) The annual license fee is \$1,000.
16 17	(6) (I) A license may be obtained by Sailwinds <u>Park</u> <u>OF</u> <u>CAMBRIDGE</u> , Inc., a nonprofit organization.
18 19 20	(II) The license may be obtained and renewed so long as no individual or group of individuals derive any personal profits from the operation of the Park SAILWINDS OF CAMBRIDGE, INC.
21 22 23	(III) WHEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SERVED AT AN EVENT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AT SAILWINDS Park <u>OF CAMBRIDGE</u> , INC., THE LICENSEE:
