## A BILL ENTITLED

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L	AN	ACT	concerning

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## Public Health - Glucose Testing - Permit

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person to obtain a certain permit from the Department 4 of Health and Mental Hygiene before offering to provide a glucose test and 5 conducting the glucose test outside a certain permanently located medical 6 laboratory; providing that a glucose testing permit is not required for a medical 7 laboratory under certain circumstances; requiring the Secretary of Health and 8 Mental Hygiene to adopt certain regulations; prohibiting the Secretary from 9 requiring glucose testing personnel that conduct certain glucose tests to be certified in a medical laboratory specialty; requiring certain glucose testing to 10 be overseen by a certain supervisor; prohibiting a person from offering glucose 11 12 testing in the State unless the person holds a certain permit; defining a certain 13 term; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to glucose testing and medical laboratories. 14

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Health General
- Subtitle 5. Cholesterol AND GLUCOSE Testing.

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1	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
2 3	(b) "Cholesterol testing" includes collecting a test specimen, testing to detect the amount of cholesterol in an individual's blood, and the reporting of test results.
4 5 6	(C) "GLUCOSE TESTING" INCLUDES COLLECTING A TEST SPECIMEN TESTING TO DETECT THE AMOUNT OF GLUCOSE IN AN INDIVIDUAL'S BLOOD AND THE REPORTING OF TEST RESULTS.
7	[(c)] (D) "Permit" means a permit issued by the Secretary to a person who:
8 9	(1) Offers to provide, with or without charge, a test to detect the amount of cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> in an individual's blood; and
10 11	(2) Conducts the test outside a permanently located medical laboratory issued a permit or excepted from a permit under Subtitle 2 of this title.

13 14	(a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section and § 17–503 of this subtitle, a person shall obtain a permit from the Department before:
15 16	(1) Offering to provide a test to detect the amount of cholesterol <b>OF GLUCOSE</b> in an individual's blood; and
17 18 19	(2) Conducting the cholesterol test <b>OR GLUCOSE TEST</b> outside a permanently located medical laboratory issued a permit or excepted from a permit under Subtitle 2 of this title.
20 21	(b) A cholesterol testing permit <b>OR A GLUCOSE TESTING PERMIT</b> is not required under this subtitle for a medical laboratory that:
22	(1) Is licensed under Subtitle 2 of this title; and
23 24	(2) As set forth in the license, provides tests or services in the discipline of chemistry or health awareness.

26 27 28 29	(a) The Secretary shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this subtitle, including regulations that assure the citizens of this State that cholestero testing <b>OR GLUCOSE TESTING</b> conducted outside a permanently located medical laboratory meets appropriate national standards of quality assurance.

The regulations shall include: (b)

$\frac{1}{2}$	(1) Personnel training standards, including requirements for reasonable training, experience, and competency in:
3 4	(i) Simple procedures used in drawing blood for cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> testing; and
5 6	(ii) The operation of blood chemical analyzers used for cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> screening;
7	(2) Quality assurance standards;
8	(3) Standards for counseling and referral procedures;
9	(4) Standards for releasing and reporting test results; and
10 11	(5) A prohibition on the payment of any sum to any person for bringing or referring a patient.
12 13 14	(c) (1) The Secretary may not require that cholesterol testing personnel OR GLUCOSE TESTING PERSONNEL that conduct cholesterol OR GLUCOSE tests under this subtitle be certified in a medical laboratory specialty.
15 16 17	(2) All cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> testing conducted under this subtitle shall be overseen by a supervisor knowledgeable in all aspects of cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> testing services.

19 20 21	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person may not offer cholesterol <b>OR GLUCOSE</b> testing in this State unless the person holds a permit from the Secretary.
22	(b) The permit is not transferable.
23 24	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
