12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(g) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person,
17	other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may not
18	shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the
19	"safety zone," of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp
20	occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this
21	area, without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

For archery hunters in **CARROLL COUNTY OR** Frederick County, 22(2)23the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from

a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human
beings.

3 (3) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or 4 occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety 5 zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2012.
